



°F250 BBQ FUNDRAISER GUIDELINES

Please review the following guidelines and complete the attached °F250 BBQ Fundraiser application. If your organization meets the °F250 BBQ Fundraiser criteria, return the completed application to the restaurant's Fundraising Coordinator a minimum of 30 days prior to requested °F250 BBQ Fundraiser.

Please Note: Submitting completed application does not mean Fundraiser is approved at this point. Our Fundraising Coordinator will contact you to finalize details and discuss next steps.

WHAT IS A °F250 BBQ FUNDRAISER?

Fahrenheit 250 BBQ is proud to support organizations in our community and we feel this program optimizes our ability to give back to our community as much as our community gives to us. The fundraising event takes place at Fahrenheit 250 BBQ on a specified evening. The benefiting organization will promote the °F250 BBQ Fundraiser to community members. The Organization will receive 20% of the sales [excluding sales tax and gratuity] from the Organization's guests when the event flyer is presented. °F250 BBQ Fundraisers are held Tuesday – Thursday. The date/time will be determined by the Fundraising Coordinator upon event approval. A °F250 BBQ Fundraiser Flyer will be emailed to your Organization no later than three weeks prior to event. It is the responsibility of the Organization to distribute the event flyers via email/print to their supporters. °F250 BBQ Fundraiser flyers must be presented to servers at the restaurant to ensure donations. Servers will then attach event flyer to the guest check and the Organization will receive 20% of all food and beverage sales from the °F250 BBQ Fundraiser Flyer redemption.

A FEW SIMPLE RULES:

- Have a fun and profitable event.
- Applications must be received by Fundraising Coordinator a minimum of 30 days prior to event.
- Event Flyers must be presented to servers to ensure credit for your Organization.
- Promotional pricing or coupons may not be used for Fundraising Events.
- Seating cannot be guaranteed for large parties.
- Although it is a scheduled °F250 BBQ Fundraiser, Fahrenheit cannot give preferential seating for Event.
- Organizations are not permitted to distribute flyers, signage or pamphlets on Fahrenheit 250 BBQ premises [including parking lot].
- Organization must receive approval from any private property owner to distribute/ solicit flyers on premises [e.g., placing flyers on cars].
- If the Organization fails to bring in a minimum of \$250 in sales, the 20% donation will be made in the form of Fahrenheit 250 BBQ Gift Cards [redeemable for future food and beverage purposes].
- Flyers cannot be used to purchase Gift Cards.

DISCRIMINATION

Fahrenheit 250 BBQ will not support organizations that discriminate against a person or a group on the basis of age, political affiliation, race, national origin, ethnicity, gender, disability, sexual orientation or religious belief.
